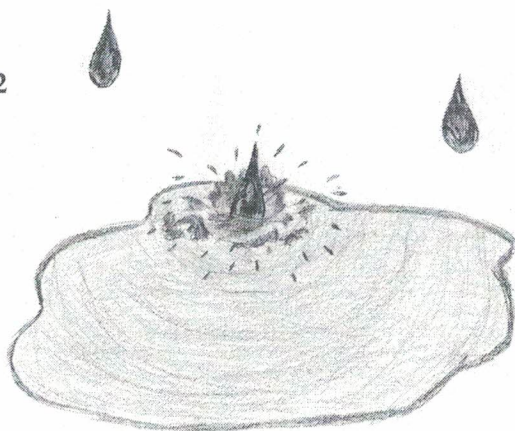
Rain Poem – Voice 1
